

## Discovering Choices Frequently Asked Questions for Students:

### Why Discovering Choices?

Outreach Education provides flexible hours and personalized programming.

Complete courses towards your diploma, certificate, HED or complete specific classes to prepare you to enter post-secondary or the world of work.

Social emotional supports are available.

You can benefit from credit recovery opportunities and if employed, may be able to benefit from work experience.

We offer Dual Credit and Apprenticeship Opportunities.

Extended school hours on "late nights."

### Are there specific program requirements?

In person attendance is required - we are an in person learning program.

All students must currently possess the literacy and numeracy skills necessary to be successful in the K&E or Diploma level pathways.

For EAL students, a minimum level 3 English language proficiency is required.

Must not have met graduation requirements.

### Is there an age criteria?

The average age of our students is 18+ years old.

We accept students between the ages of 16-19 years old that have experienced at least one semester at a community high school.

### How many courses can a student complete in a semester?

Students start with two courses and consult with staff on a regular basis to establish their individualized academic plan.

Students will develop/adapt their goals as they progress throughout the year.

Students may also be concurrently registered with their community high school in order to access various core/CTS/Fine Arts/Languages courses.

### Can students earn a Certificate of Achievement?

Yes, although our outreach facilities have limitations in the number of opportunities they can provide for the CTS requirements of a Certificate of Achievement. For that reason, previous credit attainment from a traditional high school is highly encouraged.
